

The State of New Jersey is seeking interested applicants for senior, supervisory, and entry-level positions in the newly created Office of the State Comptroller. The Office of the State Comptroller, created by an act of the New Jersey Legislature (P.L. 2007, c.52 (N.J.S.A. 52:15C-1)), is an independent office which will perform three primary functions: (1) financial audits of government entities, (2) performance reviews of government programs, and (3) review of public procurement procedures. The mission of the Comptroller's Office is to ensure the efficient and appropriate use of taxpayer dollars.
